1. The meeting was called to order at 2003 CST by the Chair

3. Reports
 - a. GLR. GLR had a meeting last Sunday. They are currently working on RCLS curriculum, an in face meeting, and they also sent out a regional Encampment survey for the standardization of encampments. They recently held their region cadet competition, where Illinois won both the Drill Team and Color Guard portions
 - b. NCR. Reported on their region cadet competition, and their preparation for the next term's council.
 - c. SER. Reported that the SER Council had completed two position papers and that they would be brought up for discussion during open floor.
 - d. SWR. SWR has a new Deputy Chief of Staff for Cadet Programs, Lt Col Trupp. The council is discussing the proposed changes to the National Cadet Competition, and the region recently had it's region cadet competition. Arizona was champion for both Drill Team, and Color Guard.
 - e. NHQ. Curt LaFond reported that NCSAs are well underway, and being run successfully. It was also noted that new achievement tests have been written, they are currently being field tested, and should be sent to the individual squadrons by July 4th
4. Old Business
 - a. Official Vote on Eaker Mini-Medal (Chair) The council voted the proposal of the Eaker Mini-Medal brought forth by AZWG's C/Col Timothy Humphries and C/Col Andrew Hay, in 2003. The proposal received a unanimous approval, and will be taken to the proper officials.
 - b. Vote on CAC ribbon proposal (GLR). The council unanimously approved the proposal made by GLR.
 - c. Discussion of Volunteer Magazine Proposal (GLR). After reviewing the second issue of the Volunteer Magazine, a revised proposal was made by GLR. The new paper address issues

such as region news and awards issued by NHQ. After discussion the proposal was put to a vote, and was approved unanimously.

5. New Business

- a. Review of NCAC Constitution (SWR). It has been noted that some areas of the NCAC constitution may need wording revisions, or clarifications. SWR brought forth the proposal, but it was decided that a summary of proposed changes needed to be reviewed by all members of the council before deciding what the proper actions may be. The issue was tabled until the next meeting

6. Open Floor

- a. Promotion Board Requirements (SER). SER proposed that to ensure the quality of our cadet officers the Earhart, Eaker, and Spaatz Awards should all have required Wing Promotion Boards for a cadet to gain promotion approval. After much discussion including feasibility of the proposal and the squadron level responsibility of promotion approval it was decided that the issue should receive further discussion over the NCAC yahoo-group.
- b. Recruiting Committee Update (GLR). The committee reported a new idea found in some areas coined "Aim Low." The idea behind the program is that recruiting may be an issue once American youth reach Middle School as they are becoming active in clubs, sports, band, etc. The program says that material should become available to the 10-12 year old age group so they may become immersed in CAP prior to the allowable age of joining. After discussion it was decided that recruiting is 100% as important as retention. The council decided to add the Recruiting committee to the standing Retention of 16-17 year old cadet Committee to form one standing Recruiting and Retention Committee.

7. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for 4 June 2006 from 2000-2100 Central Standard Time.

8. The meeting was adjourned at 2101 CST by the Chair.
