### CAP EMERGENCY SERVICES TRAINING AND OPERATIONAL MISSIONS

CAPR 60-3, dated 26 May 2004, is supplemented as follows:

2-2. Documentation of training tasks and specialty qualification will be recorded in the online e-services Operations Qualification application.

2-2.a. Qualified Supervisors, and the specialties they are authorized to certify, must be identified in writing. Those supervisors authorized to perform specialty qualification renewal evaluations will be specifically designated as Evaluators. The Qualified Supervisors and ES Evaluators must be approved by the Wing Commander.

2-2.d. Subsequent CAP Forms 101 (renewals) will be approved at the wing level.

2-4.b.(2). ES Evaluators will document renewal evaluations on a Specialty Qualification Training Record (SQTR) for the applicable specialty. Record evaluator name, CAPID, date, and mission number. The evaluator will sign the SQTR, provide a copy to the member for their individual CAPF 114 record, and forward a copy to DOS. DOS will record the renewal of the specialty in E-Services Operations Qualifications.
